





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Certification for 2.7 million of Indonesian teachers


Teacher Certification Program

- An initiative by the central government to improve the teachers' quality
- Can be achieved in two ways:
 a. One year certification program (not in practice yet)
 - b. Portfolio assessment



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Issues on the teachers' professional development program



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- The professional development program is short term or 'one shot' training
- Training providers focus on the quantity rather than quality








The process : Program Development




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The process : Program Implementation and Monitoring




The Challenges


- •Lack of evaluation culture, specially in public sectors
